- Has the Centre been through assessment and rating?
- How does the pick-up and drop off process work at your Centre?
- Do you offer casual care bookings for when I need them?
- · What is included in the daily fees?

ABOUT YOUR CHILD

- How will you keep me updated on what my child is learning?
- · What kind of learning opportunities will my child have?
- What kinds of meals do you serve at the Centre? Can I see a menu?
- How will I know how much my child ate and when they slept?
- How will you let me know if my child is experiencing any difficulties or issues in care? And how will this be managed?

ABOUT SAFETY AND HEALTH

- · How do you handle sick children at the Centre?
- Do you have protocols for administering medication if needed?
- Do you have a sun safety policy?

EDUCATORS

- What qualifications do your Educators have?
- Do you have qualified Teachers in your rooms?
- What training, development and mentoring do you provide for your teams?
- What curriculum do you follow for children of different ages?
- · Are team members trained in First Aid?

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

- What is your approach to learning and education for young children?
- What is the daily routine like for children?
- How much time do children spend outdoors?
- Are there any enrichment programs or extracurricular activities offered?

PRESCHOOL/KINDERGARTEN

- Do you have a Preschool or Kindergarten program?
- Can I get extra subsidies from the state government to help with out-of-pocket fees for Preschool/ Kindergarten?
- · How will you help prepare my child for school?

GENERAL QUESTIONS

- How can I stay connected with what is happening in the Centre?
- Can I claim the Child Care Subsidy?
- Can you tell me what my fees will be after I claim the Child Care Subsidy?
